

Coronavirus - information for parents about the daily routine at school

We have implemented a number of measures at schools to limit infection. The green, red and yellow traffic light system shows which infection control measures apply to the different levels at schools. The infection situation in Norway determines which level applies to schools.

It is safe for children to go to school

We will continue to ensure a good and safe school environment for pupils. Everyone working in the schools will keep an eye on the pupils to ensure they are doing okay. We will focus on ensuring expedient infection control in the time ahead. The following are particularly important:

- No one must go to school or after-school programmes (SFO) if they are ill.
- Wash your hands before you go to school.
- Good hand hygiene and cleanliness are important at school.

What will the daily routine at school be like?

Green level: School will function as normal, but pupils and teachers must avoid shaking hands and hugging.

Yellow level: Whole school classes can be together, and all pupils will have normal school days and can attend school full-time. The school playground will be divided into zones to keep the different classes apart. Pupils and teachers must avoid shaking hands, hugging and large gatherings.

Red level: The pupils will be divided into small groups. It may be necessary to limit how many pupils can come to school. We may also ask the pupils to come to school at different times. We must keep a good distance from each other, and the pupils will spend a lot of time outside, including during ordinary lessons.

School transport

Yellow level: Pupils who need school transport can take a bus or another form of transport to and from school. Pupils should keep a distance from each other, but pupils are not required to keep a distance of one metre from other pupils, although this is required of other passengers.

Red level: If the pupils take a school bus or another form of transport, they must remember to keep a good distance, both on the bus and while they wait for it. The pupils should consider whether they can take a different form of transport to school.

Compulsory school attendance for all pupils

All pupils are entitled to education, and the school must ensure that there is good educational provision for all pupils irrespective of whether the infection level is green, yellow or red.
