Why should you complete the Pupil Survey?

The Pupil Survey is your chance to have your say about what you think about learning and well-being at your school. Your school, your municipality and the national authorities will use your answers to make your school even better. The answers you give on the Pupil Survey may also be used by researchers. Some results from the survey will also be published on www.udir.no/statistikk.

How does the Pupil Survey work?

The Pupil Survey is completely voluntary, and you can skip any questions that you don't want to answer.

We protect your answers

You will not be asked to give your name when you complete the Pupil Survey. That means your answers will not be connected to your name. Schools, school owners and the national authorities will see the overall results of the survey, but we will never share your answers with others if your answers could reveal your identity.

The Norwegian Directorate for Education and Training is responsible for properly storing and using your answers to the Pupil Survey.
